# Day 9

If they have sinned, they will be forgiven. Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective. Elijah was a human being, even as we are. He prayed earnestly that it would not rain, and it did not rain on the land for three and a half years. Again he prayed, and the heavens gave rain, and the earth produced its crops. My brothers and sisters, if one of you should wander from the truth and someone should bring that person back, remember this: Whoever turns a sinner from the error of their way will save them from death and cover over a multitude of sins. James 5:13-20*

# Day 10

Pray today for those between jobs and those in our church who are struggling financially. There are many in our church struggle daily to make ends meet. There are many who feel overwhelmed by financial pressures. Pray that God would bring peace to their lives. Pray that He would provide for all of their needs. Pray that He would help them to escape the debt and desperation that has entrapped them. Give thanks that God has more than enough to provide for our every need.

# Day II
